YOU WILL BE ASKED ABOUT: (documents are helpful but NOT required)

- **Identification** – Know or bring social security number OR Alien ID and Document Number. MUST be citizen or legal permanent resident for 5 years to qualify. Non-citizen adults may apply on behalf of children with citizenship.
- **Job Income** – Pay stubs from past month, if available
- **Other Income** – Social Security, Child Support, Unemployment, SSI, Checking/Savings Statements, Veterans Benefits, Pension, Retirement
- **Residency** – Know your exact rent, mortgage, association dues, insurance, and property tax
- **Seniors 60+, Blind, and/or Disabled Only:** Itemized medical expenses
